

ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**FUNDING FOR THE PREPARATION OF A JOINT LIBRARY FACILITY
GRANT APPLICATION UNDER THE CALIFORNIA READING AND
LITERACY IMPROVEMENT AND PUBLIC LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION AND
RENOVATION BOND ACT OF 2000**

**WESTERN PLACER UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
SIERRA JOINT COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT
CITY OF LINCOLN**

Whereas, the voters of the State of California approved Proposition 14, the California Reading and Literacy Improvement and Public Library Construction and Renovation Bond Act of 2000, which provides sixty-five per cent funding for eligible library construction and project costs, with local agencies providing matching funds for the remaining eligible costs, and,

Whereas, first priority for Proposition 14 funding of new public libraries will be given to joint use projects in which the agency that operates the library and one or more school districts have a cooperative agreement specifying their commitment to provide joint use library services, and,


Whereas, the Western Placer Unified School District Board of Trustees, the Sierra Joint Community College District Board of Trustees and the City Council of the City of Lincoln have each approved the concept of a joint Library facility to be located adjacent to a shared school campus at the Twelve Bridges site in Lincoln, and,

Whereas, the Proposition 14 grant application requires significant advance planning, and the preparation of several supporting documents, including a Library Needs Assessment, a Library Plan of Service, a Library Building Program, conceptual architectural plans and other documents, estimated to require funding in the amount of \$200,000, and,

Whereas, the Western Placer Unified School District Board of Trustees, the Sierra Joint Community College District Board of Trustees and the City Council of the City of Lincoln have each appropriated one-third of the estimated cost of preparing the grant application and supporting documents,


Now, therefore be it resolved that this Administrative Memorandum of Understanding is executed to implement the intentions of the governing boards of the three agencies to jointly fund the cost of preparing the grant application and supporting documents, and to establish the following procedures:

1. The City of Lincoln will receive, verify and pay all invoices for costs incurred in preparing the grant application and associated documents.
2. The City of Lincoln will invoice the Western Placer Unified School District and the Sierra Joint Community College District on a quarterly basis for such costs that are incurred.
3. The Western Placer Unified School District and the Sierra Joint Community College District shall remit their payments to the City of Lincoln within forty-five days of receipt of each invoice.
4. The current estimated cost of \$200,000 shall not be exceeded unless the representatives of the three agencies authorize additional costs and agree on payment for such additional costs.
